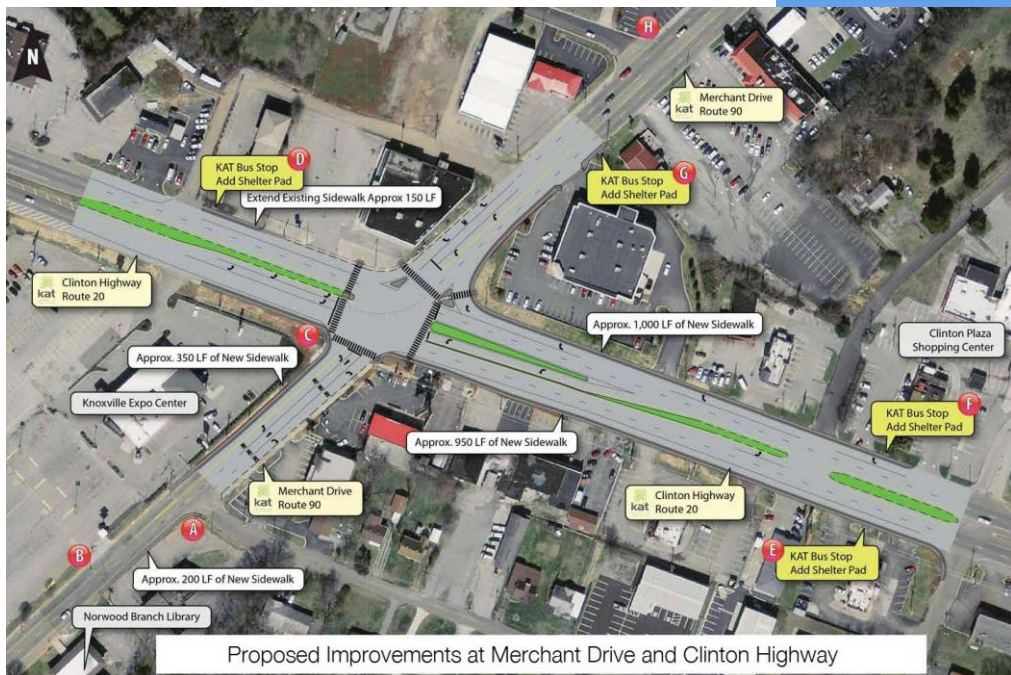




Merchant Drive at Clinton Highway Intersection Improvements Project

Project Description: The Merchant Drive/Clinton Highway project consists of constructing intersection improvements to allow for more efficient turning movements and storage for vehicles, extending sidewalks to provide access to nearby KAT bus stops and adding safer pedestrian crossings with signals and refuge islands. Additionally, gas, water, and sewer lines will be relocated for KUB as part of this project.
