SUBJECT: Quarterly Administrative Revie Concerns (2nd Quarter 2018)	w of Agency Practices Including Citizen

As required by CALEA Standards and KPD General Order 1.41, the Internal Affairs Unit conducted a quarterly review of bias based profiling issues for the second quarter of 2018. After the review of relevant data and reports, there is no indication that any officer in this department is involved in bias based profiling.

During the second quarter of 2018, the Internal Affairs Unit received no racial profiling complaints. The Internal Affairs Unit will continue to review and aggressively follow-up on any citizen complaints of this nature.

Clarence Vaughn of the Police Advisory and Review Committee was contacted regarding citizen complaints that involved bias based profiling. He stated that P.A.R.C. received one racial profiling complaint during the 2nd quarter of 2018. The case was reviewed by Clarence Vaughn, and he found that the officer's actions were lawful and proper without any evidence of racial profiling.

A review of the 2018 Recruit Academy curriculum confirmed that all officers are still receiving extensive training regarding bias based profiling and diversity issues to include legal aspects, as required by departmental policy. The curriculum for the current and any upcoming Recruit Academy will be reviewed to ensure this practice remains in place.

The outcome of this review of bias based profiling indicates that all department personnel have followed policy, as well as guidelines established by CALEA. There are no recommended changes to departmental policy at this time.

Additionally, the following included data was reviewed and there were increases from the previous quarter.

- Arrests increased between the 1st quarter of 2018 and the 2nd quarter of 2018 (from 2716 to 2994), the number of suspects also increased (from 7517 to 7690).
- State Seizures and DAGs —this report showed a decrease in the total number of seizures from the 1st quarter of 2018 to the 2nd quarter of 2018. In the 1st quarter of 2018 there was a total of 40 seizures. In 2nd quarter of 2018 there was a total of 34 seizures.
- Citations-The number of citations for the 1st quarter of 2018, when compared to the 2nd quarter of 2018 show an increase in the number of citations issued (from 6197 to 7644).
- Field Interviews-When the 1st quarter of 2018 is compared to the 2nd quarter of 2018, there was a decrease in the number of Field Interviews (from 2870 to 2557).

### Racial Profiling Report 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter

(April 1, 2018 – June 30, 2018)

There was one alleged racial profiling case received by PARC during the 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter.

### Case #1 Summary:

PARC received a complaint from a concerned citizen in reference to an alleged incident of Racial Profiling involving a Knoxville Police Department officer. The complainant stated that he was driving on Middlebrook Pike and was followed by the officer. The complainant continued to drive to a familiar location, in which he was stopped by the officer. The complainant was cited for "Disregarding the Stop Sign" and "Illegal Window Tinting". The complainant was alleging that he was stop and followed due to being an African American male, and he stated that he is very fearful of having any future interactions with the Knoxville Police Department.

### Conclusion:

The initial complaint received involved allegations of Racial Profiling by an officer of the Knoxville Police Department. After further review of the officer's audio and video recordings regarding the incident, it was noted that the complainant was informed about his violations of Failing to Stop and Illegal Window Tinting. The complainant was seen failing to stop on multiple occasions. The complainant's window tint was visibly lower than the lawful percentage, which made it difficult for the officer to view inside of the vehicle Therefore, the conclusion of the complaint identified that the officer's actions were deemed to be lawful and proper. In addition, the officer did not provide any evidence to confirm that Racial Profiling or Bias Based Policing occurred during the traffic stop.

### **KPD Policy and Procedure Reviewed:**

### **General Order 1.41 Bias Based Policing**

### I. Policy

It is the policy of the Knoxville Police Department that we are committed to preserving the peace and maintaining order in the City of Knoxville by practicing bias-free policing and respecting the rights and dignity of all citizens.

### II. Definition

Bias Based Profiling - The practice of stopping, detaining or searching a person based solely upon a common trait or a group that includes but is not limited to their race, color ethnicity, age, gender sexual orientation, religion, economic status or any other identifiable group characteristic.






## 2ND QUARTER 2018 CITES - COMPARISION BY AGE Percentages Rounded to Nearest Whole Number


### Percentages Rounded to Nearest Whole Number 2ND QUARTER 2018 CITES COMPARISION BY RACE
